

THE 6TH ICB PHARMA AUTHOR GUIDELINES

1. Authors who wish to **make a presentation (only)** are required to submit an abstract via the ICB Pharma 6 website. It is imperative that submitted abstracts adhere to the ICB Pharma 6 abstract template, which can be accessed via the following link:
<https://conferences.ums.ac.id/pharma/scheduled/pharma6/page/reg> .
2. Authors who wish to **make a presentation and publication** may submit a full paper through the ICB Pharma 6 website. Full papers submitted must adhere to the ICB Pharma 6 full paper template, which can be accessed via the following link:
<https://conferences.ums.ac.id/pharma/scheduled/pharma6/page/reg> .
3. The organizing committee will issue a **Letter of Acceptance (LoA)** as an official statement that the participant's **abstract or full paper may be presented** at the ICB Pharma 6 event.
4. For the **purpose of publication**, the organizing committee will issue a **letter of recommendation for publication**. This letter will state that the participant's full paper **is recommended for publication** in the ICB Pharma 6 partner journal.
5. Subsequent to the initial submission, authors **are required to** submit their full papers independently to the selected journal, by attaching the recommendation letter from the ICB Pharma 6th organizing committee. Authors must conform to the template of the selected journal. The URL link to the partner journal is provided in the following link:

6. The submission process, review process, and APC payment adjusting to the mechanisms and provisions of the selected journal.
7. The **decision to accept a manuscript for publication** is determined by the Editor in Chief of the journal in question.
8. For IJAP, the committee will submit articles collectively. Authors make APC payments through the committee, which will then make collective payments to the IJAP journal.

TECHNICAL GUIDELINES FOR ORAL PRESENTATIONS

1. General Requirements

- Each team is allowed to submit a maximum of 2 articles.
- Articles must be original, unpublished, and not submitted to other events.
- Articles may contain scientific research results (original research) or review results (systematic review).
- Use proper and correct English.

2. Time Allocation (Total: 10 minutes)

- Presentation: 7 minutes
- Discussion / Q&A: 3 minutes
- The moderator also acts as a judge.

3. Themes & Subthemes

- Main Theme:
“Integrating Artificial Intelligence, Advanced Technologies, and Clinical Pharmacy for the Future of Precision Medicine”
- Subthemes (Tracks):
Track 1: Pharmaceuticals and Applied Materials for Drug Delivery
Track 2: Pharmacology and Toxicology
Track 3: Clinical Pharmacy
Track 4: Pharmacy Practices
Track 5: Medicinal and Pharmaceutical Chemistry
Track 6: Pharmacognosy & Ethnobotany
Track 7: Microbiology and Biotechnology

4. PPT Slide Structure & Number

- Maximum of 10–12 slides for a 7-minute presentation.
- Minimum font size of 18 pt and easy for the audience to read.
- Use the provided design (attached template).
- It is recommended to use more points, graphs, tables, and images than long texts.
- The presentation content includes:

- a. Title & Author Identity (include affiliation & funding acknowledgement, if any)
- b. Background & Objectives
- c. Research Methodology
- d. Results
- e. Discussion / Implications
- f. Conclusion & Recommendations
- g. Acknowledgements / Closing

5. Technical Requirements for PPT & Video

- PPT format: in PDF file (for submission).
- Presentation video format: MP4, maximum 7 minutes, minimum resolution 720p (HD), landscape orientation.
- Presentation language: English.
- The presenter must appear in the video (face recording alongside the slides).
- Use a neat and professional background.
- Use relevant supporting visuals (images, graphs, tables).
- Video file size: ≤100 MB.

6. File Name Format

- PPT: [OralID]_Oral_[PresenterName]_[ShortTitle].pdf
- Video: [OralID]_Oral_[PresenterName]_[ShortTitle].mp4
- Deadline: November 30, 2025.

7. Notes (please pay close attention)

- **For online oral presentation participants**, you have to submit presentation file and presentation video (no longer than 7 minutes). Videos longer than 7 minutes will be returned for revision.
- **For offline oral presentation participants**, there are options:
 - a. If the presentation will be delivered directly, simply submit the presentation file.
 - b. If the presentation will be delivered via video, you have to submit a presentation file and presentation video (no longer than 7 minutes). Videos longer than 7 minutes will be returned for revision.

TECHNICAL GUIDELINES FOR SCIENTIFIC POSTER COMPETITION

1. Event Theme

- Theme: “Integrating Artificial Intelligence, Advanced Technology, and Clinical Pharmacy for the Future of Precision Medicine”
- Sub-themes:
 - a. Track 1: Pharmacy and Applied Materials for Drug Delivery
 - b. Track 2: Pharmacology and Toxicology
 - c. Track 3: Clinical Pharmacy
 - d. Track 4: Pharmacy Practice
 - e. Track 5: Medicinal Chemistry and Pharmacy
 - f. Track 6: Pharmacognosy & Ethnobotany
 - g. Track 7: Microbiology and Biotechnology

2. Poster Requirements

- Each team is allowed to submit a maximum of 2 posters.
- Posters must be original, unpublished, and not submitted to other events.
- Posters may contain scientific research results (original research) or review results (systematic review).
- Use proper and correct English.
- Create your poster in PowerPoint Landscape Layout (16:9) and save it as a PDF file, one slide.
- Do not print and bring posters to the event location. Everything must be in electronic format.
- File size: Less than 5 MB
- Font type: Arial, Calibri, Cambria, Times New Roman, or Helvetica are recommended.
- Font size: minimum 11 points or larger.
- Poster content must be adapted to the ICB 6 poster template. Layout and color editing/adjustments may be made to clarify the poster content.

3. Poster file name format:
